Supply List

Fabric

Bring a wide assortment of strips, varying in width from 1-2" and 5-10" long Suggestions: hand-dyed, mottled, metallic, stripes, dots, small scale prints (Fabric does not need to be cotton, bring a variety to try. Be aware that the more a fabric frays, the harder it is to work with.)

Bring any of these if you'd like to try making beads from other materials:

Shrink Plastic

Fun Foam sheets (childrens craft item)

Tyvek

Heat gun

kitchen cutting board and pot holder

Tools & Supplies

Rotary Cutter & Ruler

Small (18 or 28mm) Rotary Cutter, Decorative Blade Rotary Cutter (optional)

Paper towels

Baby wipes

Parchment, palette or freezer paper

Small rubber bands

Straight pins

Hand sewing needles-large eyes for thicker threads and floss

Styrofoam block or floral foam

two $\frac{1}{4}$ " – $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, flat, inexpensive paintbrushes

Small rubber stamps, unmounted (optional)

Grip n grip mat (optional)

Applique pressing sheet (optional)

Bring an assortment of whatever of these you have:

toothpicks, drinking straws, coffee stirrers, bamboo skewers, knitting needles

Embellishments

Ribbon 34" - 1 1/2" wide- rayon, satin and silk work great

Assorted yarns, fibers, embroidery floss, decorative thread, narrow cording to wrap/tie around beads or use for stringing

Wire- light gauge, flexible

Small beads

Angelina Fibers (optional)

Adhesives, Mediums and Paint

Glue stick Fray Check Beacon Fabri-Tac, Tacky Glue, E-6000 or any heavy duty glue
