that coordinate and contrast with the floral fabric)

Embellishments:


Yarn variety of 12" lengths
Cording variety of 12" lengths
Decorative trim variety of 12" lengths
Beads, buttons or pom poms for flower centers

Stabilizers:

Pellon 805 Wonder Under- 1 yard

(I don't recommend Heat & Bond or any heavyweight fusible for this project)

Pellon 987F Fusible Fleece- 1/2 yard

Supplies:

Pencil

Chalk or water soluble marker

Sewing machine with zig-zag or satin stitch

Machine needles Size 90/14

Cotton, poly or rayon thread to coordinate with your fabrics

Hand sewing needle and thread (for beads and buttons)

Sharp scissors for detail cutting

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Iron (for every 2-4 students)

Optional: Teflon non-stick pressing sheet for fusing

Basting spray

Free motion quilting foot Monofilament thread

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
