

Supplies for Contemporary Crazy Quilt Wallhanging

Finished Size 20" x 20"

Fabric:

Outer border	1/4 yard
Inner border and binding	1/2 yard
Crazy quilt blocks:	5 fat quarters (a variety of colors)
For center of blocks:	4 small embroidered pieces, handkerchiefs, remnants of vintage linens or appliqués
Backing and sleeve	3/4 yards
Muslin	1 fat quarter for decorative stitch practice

Embellishments:

For narrow inner border	2 yards silk ribbon or decorative trim
Assorted 6"-12" lengths of lace, decorative trims and silk ribbon	
Assorted buttons and charms	

Supplies:

1/2 yard Lightweight Stabilizer (Pellon #910 or #806 is good)
24" x 24" Batting (prefer cotton -low loft)
Cotton, poly or rayon thread that coordinates with your fabric (at least 2 colors)
Neutral piecing thread
Monofilament thread (optional)
Hand sewing needle and thread
Scissors for fabric
Rotary cutter & mat
Basting spray (optional)

Equipment:

Sewing machine with zig zag or satin stitch (required) and decorative stitches (optional) *Bring your sewing machine instruction manual to class*
Machine needles- size 90/14 (quilting, embroidery or topstitch)
Zig zag foot
Open toe embroidery foot or clear appliqué foot
1/4" foot
Walking foot (optional)
6 1/2" square ruler (optional)

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
